



**Occusolon Enyocleon Athanasios** (nicknamed *Occy*) is an eldritch horror monster from another dimension (The dimension is called Pholuria-Quarter). He has recently travelled to the human universe to escape higher authorities and conduct his research on the human species as a means of wanting to take over this universe.

He has no regard for humans but respects his other-worldly peers who are greater than him in the hierarchy. Being a lesser-known legend, he hopes his destruction of mankind will reduce his punishment from the authorities for his crimes.

Occy first came to be on earth in a different form. He required a 'development' period while he became accustomed to the atmosphere. For 100 years, he took the form of a hexagonal-sided ball, which humans passed down through generations as an item of mystery and wealth. Each side had an eye glyph shaped into it, of which he could open occasionally to look at the world around him.

Eventually, the owner of the orb and his generation died out and the Occy was placed in a museum of artifacts. Occy only spent a year there until he grew bored and finally materialised in a human form, breaking out of his glass container. That was his first experience of mortal pain.

When he first awoke in his human form, the month was July as shown to him on a calendar, so he picked that as his name thinking it was a normal human name. However, for a few weeks, he accidentally pronounced it like the name '*Julie*' instead of the word *July*, and to others, that seemed like a very strange name for him to have. He is later informed that he was pronouncing his own name wrong.

He poses as a young adult who studies law and science specifically with an interest in the human legal structure and how the nature of Earth performs. Through his powers of manipulation, he worked his way through legalities and assigned himself the human name **July Seiyer**. (*pronounced See-er, as in 'seeing'*)

On the side, he has also risen to power and become the executive manager at a well-renowned morgue and is a certified mortician. Sometimes cremated bodies go 'missing'; it's actually him hiding them away for a snack.

His eldritch form is a leviathan-type creature with a worm-shaped structure and two sets of arms with four separate arms in total. He possesses many eyes on his head, as well as on the flat fins on his back. The two longer side fins resemble cone cells. The back of his neck features exposed innards that glow once he has consumed flesh. His powers include pain manipulation, mind-control (*to a certain degree*), levitation, manifestation and mass destruction (*limited usage*). His movement in this form is limited to crawling and slithering, but he swims through the air in his own dimension.

In his human form, he can still use most of his powers to a certain extent. He won't use those that could cause the entire galaxy to crumble in an instant; he has far too much research to do still. He can also summon physical parts of his eldritch form such as his multiple eyes to use them at his will.

July is a very stern character who, given enough believable information, is also quite gullible. He can and will hurt anyone that angers him, and will dispose of them in a calm and discrete manner. His favourite thing to do is to slowly torture or bring mental pain to clueless people. Maybe one day he will grow a heart...

July's weakness is that he grows weak when someone genuinely appreciates him, as he feels he's never been appreciated for anything he's done in his realm. It is very easy to get him to let his guard down simply by thanking or complimenting him. He won't even act proud or vain about it, he might go quiet and shy for a short amount of time.

Another one of his weaknesses is sugar. He enjoys the pleasure of eating sugar, after having nothing other than flesh to consume for the past millennia. He will often have a stockpile of lollipops and other treats hidden in the desks and rooms he often visits.
