LESSON TITLE: Ayobami and The Names of the Animals	LESSON GOAL : The students will listen to the video book about an African girl who dreams of going to school. But she takes a dangerous path through the jungle to get to school.
INTRODUCE THE BOOK/STORY: (Read the story or use the video link.)	The video book today is: VIDEO BOOK LINK: Ayobami and The Names of the Animals by Pilar Lopez Avila & Mar Azabal
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: (Check for Understanding)	 What were some of the animals Ayobami met in the jungle? What did Ayobami promise to do for the animals that wanted to eat her? What did the big wind do?
SUPPLIES NEEDED: Template, green or white paper, coloring pencils, glue, scissors, white & red paper Activity:	ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION: The alligator is an important character in this story. We are making alligators Activity: Paper Alligator Craft CROCODILE PAPER CRAFT
CLOSING DISCUSSION:	We will watch this short video: Alligator, Animals for Kids Video
GROUP GAME: Developmental Goal: To develop active listening. Equipment Needed: A Coin	 Read through the game instructions ahead of time so that you can teach the activity. Use an attention-getter to gather students and make sure they are listening. Explain the game, the rules, and how to play the game. Check for understanding, have a few kids and staff demonstrate play. Link to game: Heads or Tails
