

When a correct passphrase is entered into ZampanioSim's rabbit hole screen, a unique image is shown on the CCTV visual and a text passage is printed to the console. A few passwords will also play audio.

The concept of a password search is snapped over JR's knee like a tree branch by the fact that the passwords are all laid out in a [nice, neat little pile](#) in the source code for all to see. As such, the puzzle here is less about the passphrases themselves and more about where they *would* be found if FarragoFiction weren't an abominable hellpit (affectionate) where budding Wastes run rampant. As JR puts it:

BLATANT LIE (bb says this on the radio but we're not sure how it was supposed to be found)

~~MEDIAFIRE-MYTH~~ (roblos)

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THINK LIKE A SMITH (apparently related to [knucklessux.com](#) somehow)

TOY (related to doomDuet but how were we supposed to get this specifically?)

If you know something about any of these, message **the one who screams i guess#7896** to get it added to the doc. Even if the code is already "found", additional context is also welcome. Most of the sources for these come from the Zampanio Discord server, so it may be worth it to backread through the channels and see if you can find anything of use.
