* Endorsements for candidates on Zoom. Anyone who lives in those areas can watch, but only voting members can ask questions. There is a seven-day notice to the candidates and club members before the endorsement meeting. Clubs in affected areas are notified.

* Incumbents are automatically endorsed. If there is opposition, members can rally, not support the endorsement, and require the candidate appear and answer questions on their record.
