



## Electronic Assembly Technician:

- **Job Description:**

Primary duties are to assemble electronic parts, such as circuit boards, mount them into larger assemblies or casings, ensure the proper soldering and installation of electric wiring, and test or troubleshoot equipment before it is put into or returned to service.

- **Key Responsibilities:**

1. Wire, assemble, and install electrical and electronic components according to blueprint specifications
2. Perform tests on finished products before packaging
3. Complete device history records and daily production logs
4. Maintain a clean and safe workspace
5. Complete other tasks as necessary

- **Job Requirements:**

1. Soldering experience
2. Wiring experience a plus
3. Mechanical aptitude and the ability to follow directions
4. Manual dexterity

- **Equipment Knowledge:**

1. 10X to 30X microscope
2. Micrometers and calipers – both digital and analog
3. Dial Indicators
4. Electrical measuring equipment (multi-meters, oscilloscopes, DC power supplies).
5. Pressure measuring equipment.
6. Soldering irons.
7. Office Equipment: personal computer, copier/printer, fax machine and telephone
