

“Cornhole”

Grade Level: K–6th Grade

Potential Essential Questions

- How can students show teamwork and sportsmanship while playing a target game?

Lesson Objective

Students will practice throwing skills and accuracy while learning to keep score, follow rules, and demonstrate good sportsmanship.

Biblical Integration

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord." – Colossians 3:23

(Encourages effort, focus, and integrity while playing the game.)

Equipment Needed

- 1 chair each team will throw bean bags toward (already in the classroom)
- 3-6 bean bags (2 per team) (already in the classroom on the black shelf)
- Cone or floor marker to set throwing spot

How to Play

1. Create 3 even amount of teams
2. Place a chair at each station with the back facing the throwers.
3. Mark a safe throwing line with a cone(adjust distance by grade level).
4. Players take turns tossing bean bags at the chair.
 - **3 points:** Bean bag goes through the back chair slot.
 - **1 point:** Bean bag lands and stays on the chair seat.
 - **0 points:** Bean bag misses or bounces off.
5. Each player throws all their bean bags, then adds up their score.
6. Rotate players so everyone gets a turn.
7. Continue for several rounds, recording scores if desired.
