- Course Code Management Changes 2021-2022--Important information on required courses and course code changes for 2021-2022.
- Beginning with the entering ninth grade class of 2022-2023, a public high school student shall be required to earn one (1) unit of credit in an ADE-approved high school computer science course before the student graduates. The one (1) unit required may be earned in grades eight through twelve (8-12). There are nine courses that may be provided to students in Grades 8-12 without any additional approval from the ADE. Additional information about these courses can be found in Commissioner's Memo COM-21-099.

#### **Notes:**

- From Admin meeting yesterday: Discussion about staff morale: ideas to support teachers included Sonic drinks, "corn dogs", payday pancakes, Taco party celebrations; one school did a Bulletin Board #Finish Strong and winners got prizes (kids help decorate); took duties for a day; one school set aside a "calm room" where staff could go and "calm"-set up with quiet music, lotion, smells, etc.
- Bills and such
  - HB 1237 (Act 688) Authorizes the first day of school year to be as early as the Monday two weeks before Labor Day beginning with the 2022-2023 school year; prohibits waivers; provides for implementation of an alternate school calendar.
  - HB 1749 Prohibits school and university policies that require their employees to address students by their preferred pronouns. (04-21-21 S Committee Motion for Do Pass Failed)
  - SB 450 Requires school sports to be designated based on biological sex. Authorizes the Attorney General to bring a cause of action against violators for relief including an injunction barring public funding for one year. (04-21-21 H Passed (Vote: Y: 74/N: 17)
