Dear Orchestra parents and Students:

A wonderful event is coming up and I wanted to make everyone aware of another opportunity to perform!

**Solo and Ensemble Festival:** This event is open to all orchestra students! It will take place this year on Saturday, April 18th at Sterling School/Charles Town Center in Greenville.

Students can sign up to play a solo or perform as a member of an ensemble (a small group of 2-4 players). At the Festival, students play for a judge and receive a rating. The ratings are as follows: Superior, Excellent, Good, Fair & Poor. Students earning a Superior rating receive a medal and a certificate. Students who earn an Excellent or a Good rating receive a certificate.

This festival is an excellent chance for students to show off their talent, gain confidence in their playing and receive feedback from another orchestra teacher (the judge)! :)

The cost for the festival is very small: \$10 for a solo or \$5 for each ensemble member if you choose to learn a group song. Students may sign up for a solo or an ensemble or one of each. Students may not participate in more than 1 ensemble. If this fee poses a hardship, please talk with Mrs. Anderson - she has access to funds to help make this event a reality for all students!

**All Solo and Ensemble registration forms & money – must be turned in by Monday, February 23rd.** No late money or forms will be accepted! If you are playing in an ensemble, each member of the group must turn their form & money in on time!

I will work with the students to help them choose music that is good fit for their current playing ability. Students who take private lessons should ask their teacher which piece they would like for them to perform. Students in ensembles should be aware that the bulk of your rehearsals will be on your own time in morning practice or with your own location arrangement.
