

RWR Article Guidelines for Contributors

Thank you for considering writing an article for the *Romance Writers Report (RWR)*! The following serves as guidelines to ensure your article complies with RWA's policies.

Contributors must use language that is inclusive:

- If quoting or referencing a person in the article, please ask the person their pronouns and use them if/where warranted.
- Use the labels that a person uses to self-identify.
- Use language inclusive of all genders: “they/their” instead of “she/her” or “he/him,” “siblings” instead of “brothers and sisters,” etc.
- Use person-centered language (“people with disabilities,” “someone who uses a wheelchair,” etc.) unless otherwise requested.
- Recognize diverse relationship formations: avoid assumptions that all relationships involve only two people and that those two people are a man and a woman.

Please also keep in mind RWA's anti-discrimination policy:

6.1.1. In order to create a safe and respectful environment, invidious discrimination is prohibited in RWA.

6.1.1.1. No member, speaker or participant in RWA or any RWA activity, RWA function, or RWA forum or social media account shall discriminate against another member, speaker, or participant at any RWA activity, RWA function or on any RWA forum or social media account based on race, color, ethnicity, national origin, age, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, or religion.

RWR articles should comply with antitrust laws. RWA, its committees, its members, and other program participants are prohibited from:

- collectively agreeing to fix or set prices or terms for selling works, products or services;
- collectively agreeing not to deal with or to boycott certain suppliers, authors, publishers, or others, or to deal with such persons only on certain terms and conditions; and
- conspiring to exclude competitors, customers, or publishers from the market.



RWA reserves the right to engage a professional freelance copyeditor and/or proofreader to review the article prior to publication, at its sole discretion. Because this process may affect the final word count, you will have the opportunity to review any edits before publication.
