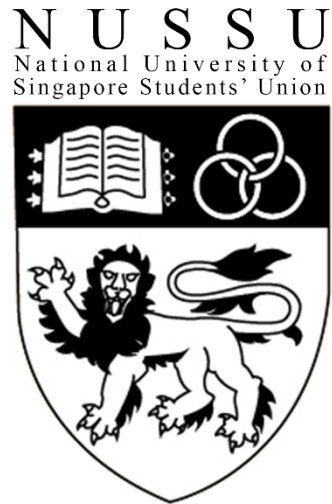

Terms & Conditions

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I. INTRODUCTION

The National University of Singapore Students' Union ("NUSSU") has set up the NUSSU Students' Fund (NSF) to assist financially needy full-time undergraduates by providing financial aid. NSF was set up to provide essential and opportune monetary assistance to students with financial needs.

II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

NSF supports students across all disciplines based on the degree of their financial needs rather than their academic or extracurricular achievements.

The eligibility criteria for the NUSSU Students' Fund are as follows:

- Full-time undergraduate students in Academic Year 2023/2024 Semester 2 (excluding NUS students on exchange overseas);
- Has a gross monthly household income (GHI) of $\leq$ S\$4,000, or a monthly per capita income (PCI) of $\leq$ S\$1,000, whichever is higher;
- Has concurrently applied for NUS Financial Aid for Academic Year 2023/2024;
- Are under the MOE Tuition Grant¹.

III. APPLICATION

Applicants who fulfilled all requirements as stated under "Section II – Eligibility Criteria" can apply on NUSync from **23 January 2024 (Tuesday) 0000hrs to 6 February 2024 (Tuesday) 2359hrs**.

All information provided in connection with the application must be true, accurate and complete. Any inaccurate, incomplete or false information given, or any omission of information required shall render the application invalid. Applicants may also be liable to disciplinary action.

¹ Undergraduates who are Singapore Citizens are under the grant by default. Undergraduates who are Permanent Residents or International Students would need to have been offered and accepted the grant to be considered as eligible.

IV. ASSISTANCE PROVIDED

Awards	Amount
Tier 1 Book Grant	\$1,000
Tier 2 Book Grant	\$600
Tier 3 Book Grant	\$300

The award of the fund is dependent on each applicant's unique financial situation.

Successful applicants will receive a one-time financial aid credited to your bank account, four (4) to six (6) weeks after the release of results. Applicants must ensure that the “**Receiving Bank Account**” details are updated. Follow the instructions [here](#) to update the details.

V. LATE APPLICATION

Should there be students who need financial assistance after the application, applicants can write in to state the reason(s) of their late application and proceed to apply accordingly should the reason(s) be deemed valid and reasonable. Unsuccessful applicants from the first round of application are welcome to apply for the fund only if they see change in circumstances and require financial assistance. The NUSSU Finance Cell will consider the application on a case-by-case basis.

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
