#### San Diego College of Continuing Education Parking Rules:

## IMPORTANT COVID-19 INFORMATION (08/19/2021)

San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) is requiring all new and returning students to present proof of COVID-19 vaccination if attending any in-person activity (including in-person exams) or class for the Fall 2021 semester.

Students enrolled in a class with an in-person component (on campus or partially online) are required to submit proof of vaccination. The deadline for classes that start the week of August 23rd is August 18th at midnight. For late-start short term classes, documentation

must be provided one week prior to the start of class or students will be dropped from their in-person class and related corequisites/linked classes.

Student parking permits are NOT required to park in student lots for Fall 2021. Students may NOT park in faculty/staff lots, citations will be issued for vehicles parked in faculty/staff lots that are not displaying a valid parking pass.
