

## **Glenbard East Financial Aid & Scholarships**

The Glenbard East School Counseling Department encourages students to complete financial aid steps based on their year in school. Some of the steps require students to log into their Schoolinks account.

## Senior Year

- Prior to October 1: <u>Create your FSA ID</u>
- Starting Oct 1: Use <u>FAFSA Completion Resources</u> to submit your FAFSA
- Apply for Scholarships
  - Schoolinks -The Glenbard East High School Local Scholarship for Seniors has a deadline of January 29, 2026. Seniors access a link to the application by logging into Schoolinks, clicking on the College tab, clicking on the Scholarship Matching Tool and viewing their matches. The GEHS Local Scholarship will show up with the highest match of 100 on their profile. Seniors can add the scholarship to their favorite list on their Scholarship Match profile and then return to their favorite list in December when the application opens.

- Compare financial aid offers from your colleges to determine which one to enroll by the May 1st Decision Day. If you apply under a binding admission plan such as Early Decision, follow the agreement and enroll earlier if you are admitted.
