## How do I access Kaltura MediaSpace?

Kaltura MediaSpace can be accessed by navigating a web browser to <https://mediaspace.udayton.edu>. If you're not logged in, click on the person icon (user menu) and select "Login". If prompted, enter your UD credentials and acknowledge the Duo 2FA prompt.

### **August 29, 2025**

Your Warpwire videos will be migrated to your [My Media](#) in [Kaltura MediaSpace](#).

### **October 2025**

Warpwire will no longer be accessible.

## When do I need to stop using Warpwire?

If you are planning to upload new videos, you're strongly encouraged to use [Kaltura MediaSpace](#). The ability to add new videos to Warpwire will be disabled shortly before the Fall 2025 term.

## What is the difference between My Media, My Channels, and My Playlists?

My Media, My Channels, and My Playlists can all be accessed in MediaSpace.

- **My Media** is your personal library, where you store all the media you've uploaded or created. [Learn more about My Media](#)
- **My Channels** contains collections of videos you've created or have access to. Channels are a way to organize content by topic or theme. [Learn more about channels](#)
- **My Playlists** contains playlists of videos you've created. Playlists are a way to organize and order related videos. [Learn more about playlists](#)
