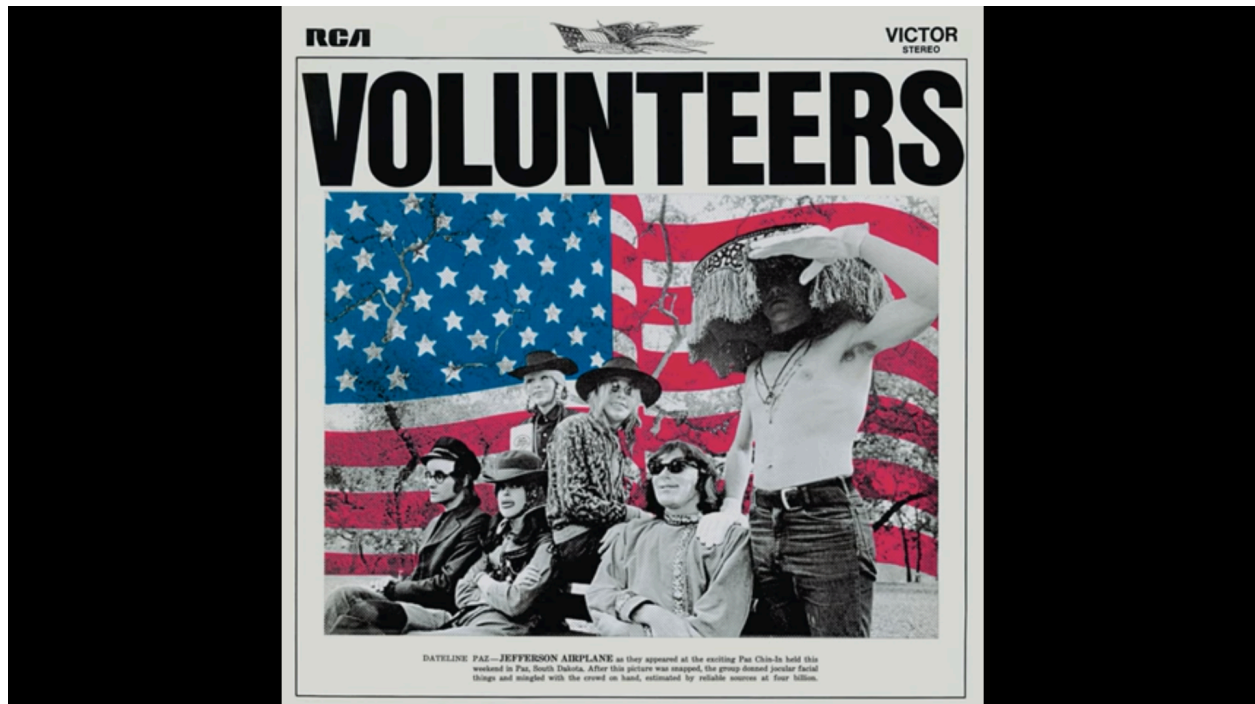
They have a war in Afghanistan. They set the Christians and the Moslems at each others throats playing at terrorism.

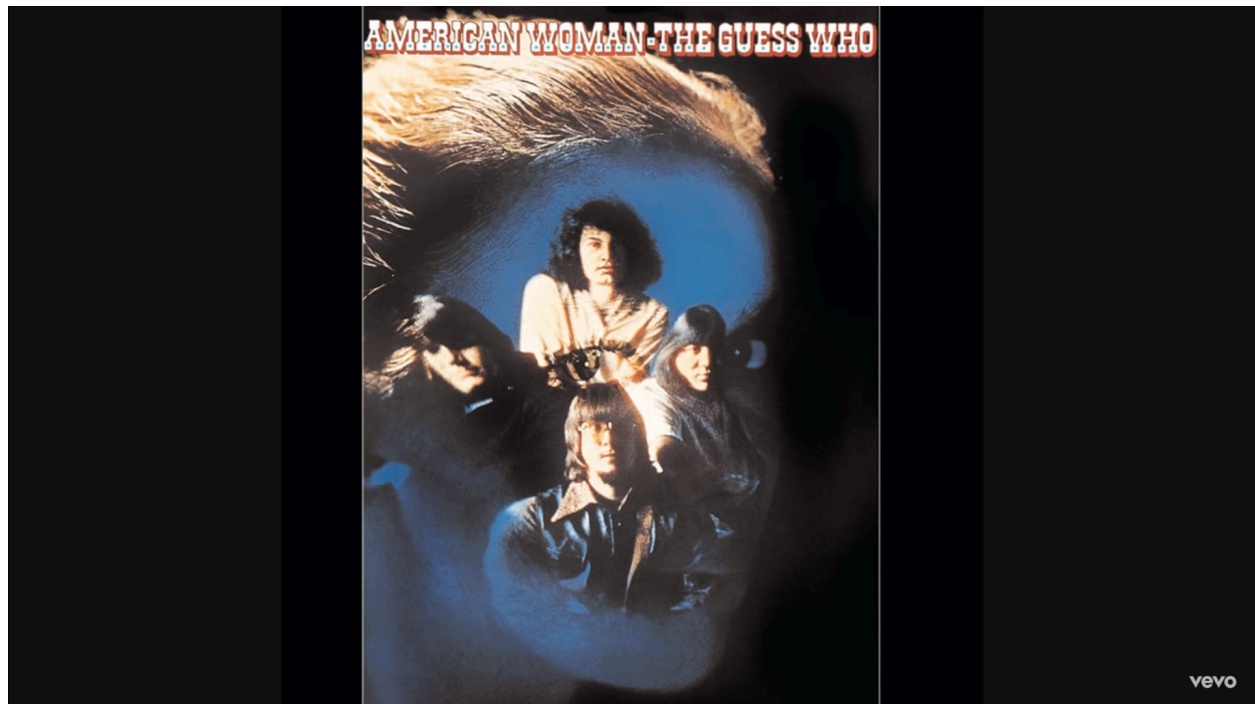

"At first, some of the kids put up signs declaring, "No heroin dealers here." Over time, Joe says, those signs came down and more and more people started using hard drugs. "All that stuff about consciousness was just sort of dropped." They saturated the streets with hard drugs that previously were unheard of!"

The Administration had struck back hard by making outrageous claims about the dangers of LSD. They used several disparate and unrelated events that may, or may not have been related to LSD to lobby to make it illegal. The Beatles struck back hard by promoting Timothy Leary as Governor of California. They wrote Come Together as his campaign song. Before the election the police stopped Timothy Leary and claimed that they found a marijuana roach in his car and he was sentenced to ten years in jail. LSD was made illegal as a ploy in the race for governor of California.

The blowing of their minds. On October 10th 1970 six days after the death of Janis Joplin the Nixon Administration passed the legislation that would start the drug wars.

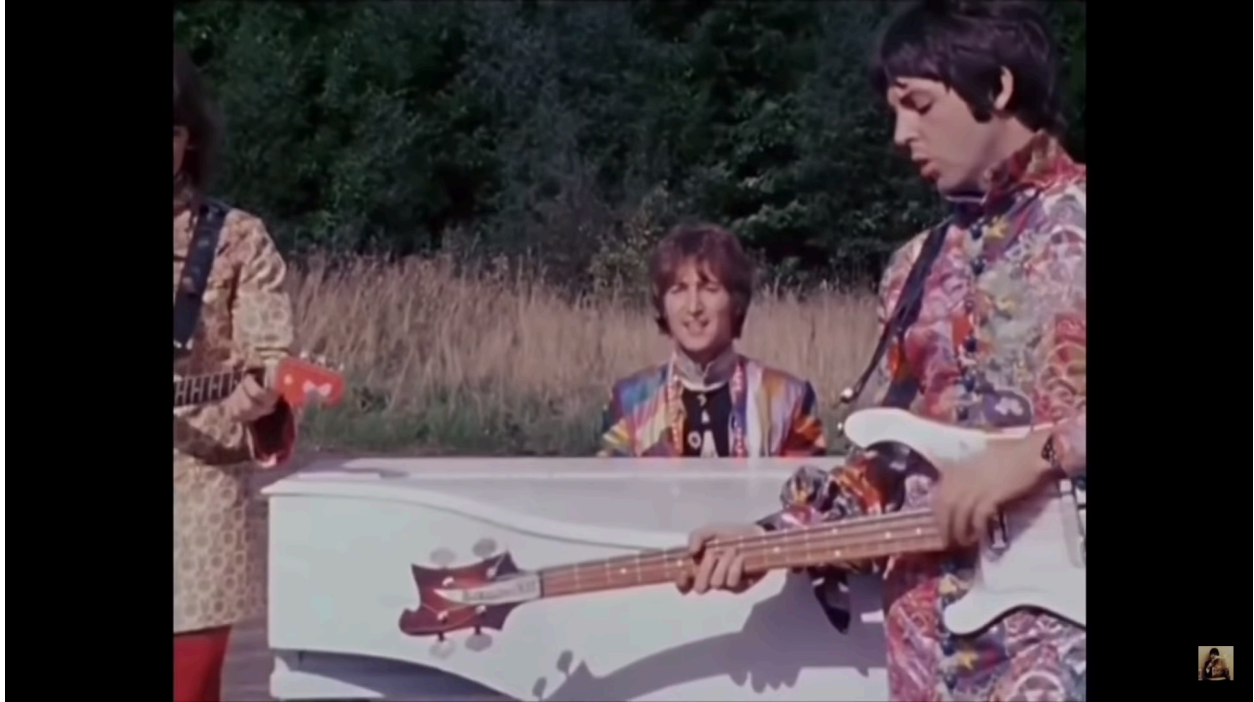
