- School Grants:
 - Mrs. Smith: \$684 for decodable readers, supplemental reading for reading groups in her class. Self Reimbursement
 - Jesse motions to approve grant for \$684 to Mrs. Smith's class, Julie seconds, all in favor
 - Mrs. Knapp: student extracurricular crocheting, \$10/kid, used during Wednesday
 Lunch Recess alternative then going outside. Self Reimbursement
 - Revise for two days a week, wants to train students who can then help others as well. Start with 4th graders, estimating 10-15 students to start
 - Lindsay moves to approve \$150 grant for Mrs. Knapp, Jill seconds, all in favor, motion passed.
 - PE: \$1000 (add'l \$200 a year), necklaces and charms, there are also STEM,
 Character Trait, Music, student achievement charms.
 - Charms used to be funded by the Mileage Club program, but was defunded. Grant will be used to replace and expand upon charms.
