#### **GENERAL ELECTION:**

- 14<sup>th</sup> day before the election if registering online or by mail.
   Or by the 7<sup>th</sup> day before the election if registering in person.
- o If a Voter is registered with a party and, they want to change parties, they must do so 3 months prior to an election. If they are unaffiliated, they can change to a party affiliation 7 days prior to

- election day in person at the registrar's office.
- Connecticut now offers Election Day Registration. If you miss the registration deadline, you can register and vote in person on each day of Early Voting or Election Day at the Government Center, 888 Washington Blvd, Stamford, CT




