You are going to create a separate page on your website for of the following topics that have been covered:

- 1. **Definitions**: Define what Human Rights and Civil Rights are and explain the similarities and differences.
- 2. **History**: Explain the background leading up to the creation of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
- 3. **Universal Declaration of Human Rights**: Explain who created the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. What are the advantages about the Universal Declaration of Human Rights? What are the disadvantages with the Universal Declaration of Human Rights? Choose <u>10</u> of the rights to put into your own words and explain their importance.
- 4. **Tank Man**: Explain Tiananmen Square and the protest that occurred there. Describe who Tank Man was and why what he did is so significant. Lastly, connect Tank Man and the protests to Human Rights.
- 5. **Historical Events**: You need to find <u>5</u> events that have happened throughout history that have a connection to Human Rights and/or Civil Rights.

- 7. **References**: Make sure to have a list of resources in MLA format that you used for the above information.
