

What is the USPS process once they receive my address change from Larimer County?

Per the USPS

1. Those address that are keeping the same primary numbers but are changing street names are sent to USPS headquarters to get an alias assigned.
 - a. At the same time we will be changing the street names.
2. For those addresses that are getting primary and street name changes, we will tie the new primary address numbers to the new street name to each.
 - a. We will then send a Change of Address letter out to the Customer letting them know what there addresses changed to and what the new + 4 is .
3. We will also notify the local post office of the address changes via a change of address letter and advise them to initiate deliveries to the new address.

Per the USPS residents that have their address changed as part of the Larimer County Rural Addressing Project process SHOULD NOT put in a USPS change of address form. It will only cause confusion.
