Service Position Requirements:

- 6 Months of Sobriety
- 1 Year Commitment term

Duties:

- Place literature orders for your group on a regular basis through aa.org. A suggestion of helpful pamphlets can be found here: [Frequently stocked A.A. pamphlets](#)
- Make an announcement at your meetings that you are the Group's Literature Representative and briefly describe what AA literature has available in addition to our Basic Text ([Alcoholics Anonymous](#)). (An example would be the [The Large Print Study edition Big Book for \\$6](#), the Book [12 Steps and 12 Traditions](#) and [A.A. Comes Of Age](#).)
- Represent your Group on the District 5 Literature Committee
- Ask your group to decide on a literature budget. (Or stay within the literature budget your group currently has.)
- Attend your group's monthly business meetings and give a report of how much money you spent on literature and what literature you ordered.
- Starting one month before you rotate out of this position, start announcing that the position will be open and that it is a fun and necessary position.
- When the next member is elected, introduce them to the District Committee Chair. Explain their duties to them by going over this list and help them to learn the ropes!

How to get started:

- Reach out to the District Literature Chair literature@district5aa.org to let them know you have been elected by your Group to be the Literature Rep.
- Start attending the District Literature Committee meetings and helping out at local events.
