Amazon Alexa Commands

- **Alexa, enable MindsEye** – First time setup to install the MindsEye Skill on an Amazon Alexa device. This only needs to be done once.
- **Alexa, Open MindsEye** – Opens the skill and speaks a list of options. This must be said each time you want to listen to a new program.
 - **Listen Live** – Plays our live stream.
 - Alexa will ask if you want to listen to the St. Louis stream or the Central Illinois stream.
 - **Play (program name)** – Plays requested program.
 - For daily news programs, say “Front Page,” “Sports,” “Obituaries,” “Editorials,” or “Features.”
 - **Directory** – Lists all available shows by category.
 - **Schedule** – Lists the current day’s schedule.
- **Alexa, Stop** -or- **Alexa, Pause** – Stops playback.
- **Alexa, Resume** – Resumes the current program.

Note – You must say “Alexa, Open MindsEye” each time you wish to listen to a new program.
