

ELECTIVES

World Languages (not required for graduation): Spanish, French, German = 1 credit each year

Fine Arts (.5 credit required for graduation):

- Art (i.e. Drawing & Painting, Ceramics, Design, Computer Art, Jewelry & Metalworking, Digital Photography) = .5 credit each semester
- Theater (i.e. Acting, Theater Design & Craft) = .5 credit each semester
- Band and Choir = 1 credit each year
- Other music classes
 - Music Production, Guitar = .5 credit each semester
 - Rock Band = 1 credit each year

Career & Technical Education “CTE” (.5 required for graduation):

- Business Education
 - Intro to Business, Business Law, Marketing = .5 credit each semester
 - Accounting, Entrepreneurship = 1 credit each year
- Computer Technology
 - Keyboarding = .5 credit each year
 - Digital Tools, Web Design, Computer Science 1, Computer Science 2 = .5 credit each semester
 - AP Computer Science = 1 credit each year
- Family & Consumer Science
 - Intro to Culinary, Baking & Pastries, Advanced Culinary, Interior Design, Fashion Construction, Early Childhood Care = .5 credit each semester
 - Child Development = 1 credit for the year
 - Intro to Teaching = 2 credits for the year
- Engineering & Design
 - Pre-Engineering, CADD, 3D Design & Animation = .5 credit each semester
 - Intro to Engineering Design, Principles of Engineering, Civil Engineering & Architecture, Engineering Design & Development, Architectural Drawing = 1 credit for the year
- Cooperative Work Training “CWT” = 2 credits for the year

Consumer Education - must choose 1 option to meet graduation requirement:

- Consumer Education class - counts as CTE = .5 credit for 1 semester
- Personal Economics - counts as social studies = .5 credit for 1 semester
- Consumer Math - counts as 3rd year of math. Can only take senior year. = 1 credit for the year. Must pass both semesters to get Consumer Ed credit.

Technology Center of DuPage “TCD” (not required for graduation) - Junior and/or Senior year only

- Most programs take up 4 periods a day. Cosmetology takes up 5 periods.

- Auto Body, Auto Technology, Computer & Game Design, Construction, Cosmetology, Criminal Justice, Early Childhood Education, Fire Science/EMT, HVAC, Manufacturing Technology, Medical Assisting, Medical Technology, Multimedia & TV production, Nursing Assistant, Culinary, Robotics, Welding = 3 credits for the year

General Credit Electives (not required for graduation)

- Film Studies, Radio, Television = .5 credit each semester
- Yearbook = 1 credit for the year

Unique Credit Classes (not required for graduation)

- LRC = .5 credit for the year
- Reading = 1 credit for the year
- Strategies for Academic Success = 1 credit for the year
- Freshman Seminar = 1 credit for the year
- AVID = 1 credit for the year

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- English - 4 credits
- Math - 3 credits
- Science - 2 credits (Biology and a Physical Science)
- Social Studies - 3 credits (Global Connections, US History, Social Studies Electives)
- PE/Health/Driver Ed - 4 credits
- Career Tech Ed - .5 credit
- Fine Art - .5 credit
- Consumer Ed - .5 credit

*1 credit = 1 year
