Despite Islamic legal provisions affirming the necessity of female consent in marriage, many respondents reported familial pressure, threats of ostracism, and emotional coercion. In several cases, women were compelled to marry based on parental social or economic alliances. The study demonstrates a clear dissonance between Islamic law, which mandates consent, and the cultural
