

Step One - Preparation for Making an Account that connects to your student(s):

- Get your child's pairing code.
 - Have your child go to their canvas account (Google Drive→ waffle → scroll down to Canvas)
 - When in Canvas, your child needs to go to Account \rightarrow Settings.

On the right side in the settings screen, there is a button "Pair with Observer" Click on this.

 \rightarrow Write down the code. This is specific to your child and expires in 7 days or one use (whatever comes first).

Step Two - Creating a Parent Account in Canvas:

- Go to https://nbexcellencewi.instructure.com/login/canvas
 - In the top right corner is "Parent of a Canvas User?" Type in your name, email, a password
 - Enter your child's pairing code in the very last text box.
 - You should see your child's courses once they have been published by the classroom teacher(s).
- To set up multiple students in the same account:
 - Retrieve other student's pairing code(s) (See step 1)
 - In your Canvas Parent Account click **Account** in the top left corner.
 - Click Observing
 - Enter the pairing code(s) for additional students you would like to add to your account.

Step Three - Logging in the Canvas Parent App:

Option 1

- Download the Canvas Parent App to your device.
- Select New Berlin Parent
- Enter your username and password information (Step 2) to sync your child's account.

Option 2

- Download the Canvas Parent App. You will see a screen to enter your school's URL or QR code.
- On a computer or laptop, sign into your Canvas Parent account.
 - To find the QR code in your Canvas Parent account, go to Account \rightarrow QR for Mobile Login



 A QR code will pop up that can be used on your phone/ipad to get a working Canvas Parent app account (if your child wants to use the Canvas student app, he/she can do the same thing from their student account)
