Best Practices - Operations

- Where do you find resources to share with your members on social media? How often?
 - Sooke: meetings, events, shareables from BCYK/National
 - North Van: Lisa (North Van socials may be good to follow for other chapters)
 - Branch Digital Coordinator: Anna Ashbarry (digital@cpf.bc.ca)
- Do you stay in touch with your members? How do you treat expired members?
 - Mailchimp reminders about expiry (contacts for expiring/expired members in monthly membership lists)
 - Mailing list with option to unsubscribe, don't remove expired members, let them unsubscribe
 - Comm template to contact expiring/expired members
 - Could contact expired members to act as a resource for FI info events
 - Saanich: sends out newsletters (welcome in Sept, holiday, year end)
 - Membership issues: Contact imacdougall@cpf.ca at CPF national
- How do you assign tasks for each Board position? Do you factor in interests and expertise?
- How do you manage Chapter records and reports? Are these shared with all the Board?

Best Practices - Events

- Does your Chapter host an annual signature event? What makes it a success?
 - Carnaval: fun winter sports event at the ski hill with tubing, snacks (OK-Skaha)
 - Welcome back event in Sept: free family activity (skating, bowling) that coincides with membership drive
 - Skating/skate with bonhomme:
 - Annual BBQ: Rotary might offer cooking/serving with foodsafe for a donation
 - French grads and grade 7 grads: Personalized grad letters (Burnaby,
 Nanaimo-Ladysmith), certificates, branch offers dual dogwood pins, French lunch

(New West)

- Grad recognition letters sent to Alicia
- French Film Festival (Burnaby)
- French Parent Info nights: Each year (North Vancouver), invite french teachers/teacher liaison to speak,
- Stay in French night geared towards grade 7 and up (N Van)
- Have you adapted an event into a virtual event? What would you do differently next time?
