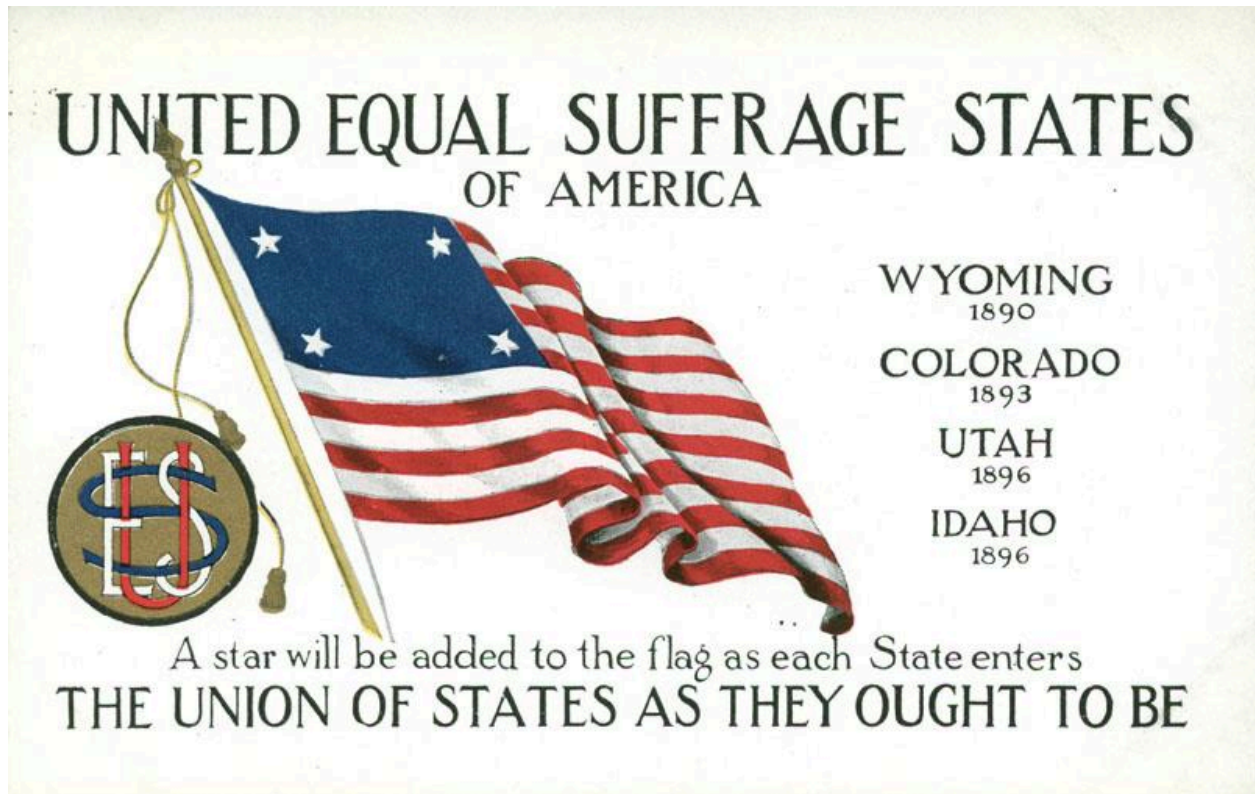

Equal suffrage refers to the concept of men and women having equal access to voting in a democracy. This postcard shows the first four states to establish equal suffrage and calls on other states to join them. Idaho implemented equal suffrage in 1896; many of the first states to enact this policy were located in the intermountain west.
