Title: The Penguin Review - A Magazine for History and Politics

Abstract:

Our group oral presentation will describe how we created The Penguin Review: A Magazine for History and Politics through a year-long History & Politics internship at Dominican University of California. We will show how our student-led magazine gives students a voice, connects historical, political, and cultural inquiry to civic affairs, and creates a space for thoughtful student work.

We will describe how we built the magazine from the ground up- defining its purpose, selecting submissions, editing student work, and promoting it across campus- while reflecting on what we learned about research, collaboration, revision, outreach, and project management. We will also consider the value of creating a student-led publication for readers beyond the classroom, what we learned from the experience, and how we hope to pass the magazine on to future student editors.
