I felt there was something I hadn't finished yet."

Doosan Bears foreign hitter Henry Ramos (32) announced on the 28th why he decided to return to the KBO League after morning training at Hisamine Stadium in Miyazaki, Japan.

Ramos made his debut in the KBO League as a member of the KT Wiz in the 2022 season. He left strong impression with a batting average of 0.387, four homers and nine RBIs in 12 exhibition games that year, but had to leave Korea after 18 games (0.250 batting average, three homers and 11 RBIs) due to bad luck breaking his toe after being hit by a pitch during the regular season. 먹튀김증

However, last year, he showed a possibility of rebounding as a member of the Triple-A Louisville Batts under the Cincinnati Reds, showing a stable performance with a batting average of 0.318, 13 homers, 55 RBIs and an on-base percentage of 0.411 in 76 games, and was caught on Doosan's radar network, which was searching for a mid- to long-range hitter with excellent accuracy.

Ramos joined the team from Friday when the first spring camp in Sydney was nearing an end. He is showing off his strengths by training in a serious manner. At a practice match with the Seibu Lions on Friday, he saw many balls and showed off an excellent batting plan. "Ramos is a player who can be our key man," Doosan manager Lee Seung-yeop said. "He has not played many games yet, but he seems to be hitting the ball thinking hard. If he enhances his sense of play in the field, he will have no problems until the opening of the regular season."

Ramos said, "I feel great so far. I'm finding the rhythm while I'm at the batter's box, and my shoulders are relaxed well," adding, "Dusan is a very good team as I thought, and the players are really nice to me. I'm enjoying it every day." "What I can do best is to play every game and do my best 100 percent," Ramos said. "I'll do everything if the coach orders me. I'm that confident."

It was also clear why he returned to the KBO League. "I went out in the middle of the game because I wasn't so lucky at the KT, but I felt like I had something that I didn't finish yet, so I decided to come back," he said. "For fans, I want to be remembered as a player who does my best 100 percent, and my biggest goal is to win more and win more than anything else. I don't need anything else if I can win the championship."
