- **Prom:** May 26, 2022 - Newton White Mansion; 7:00pm - 11:00pm

- Tickets are \$85 - The deadline to purchase tickets is **Friday May 20, 2022**

- *Attendees will be required to take a COVID-19 home test provided by PGCPs within 24 hours of the event and upload the results. Students will receive test kits at rehearsal on May 24, 2022. Guests will be required to take a COVID-19 test when they arrive at the venue. They will have to wait in their car for 15 minutes after testing. Guests will not be permitted entry without a negative test.*

- Heavy hors d'oeuvres will be served
- Staff chaperones will be in attendance

Prom Expectations:

- Reentry will not be permitted.
- All prom attendees must be under the age of 21.
- **No guests will be admitted the night of prom without a completed [Prom Guest Approval Form](#) on file.** - Deadline for submission is Friday May 20, 2022.
- Guests must remain with the student that is hosting them for the duration of the prom.
- Guests must present a current school or state issued photo ID in order to enter the venue.
- Any attendees under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances will be denied entry to the prom.

- Attire: Graduates must dress in **all black for graduation.**
 - Full length pants
 - Dress and/or skirt length should not exceed beyond the regalia,
 - Shoes should be dark and solid in color, as well as comfortable and safe for walking (e.g. safe heel height, no slippers, no flip-flops - Graduates will be walking and standing for at least three (3) hours).
 - No boots, sneakers, sweat pants or other athletic attire.

 - Please remember that graduation tickets have no monetary value. They will not be sold by CMIT South and may not be sold.
