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Abstract

The abstract is to be in fully-justified text as it is here. The abstract is to be in 10-point, single-spaced type. Abstract text length should not be longer than 250 words and should not be less than 50 words, including spaces. This limit includes the body of the abstract only. If your abstract exceeds this limit, you will be prompted to shorten it before being allowed to continue. Manuscripts should be written in English. Provide a maximum of six keywords.

Keywords: First Keyword, Second Keyword, Third Keyword, Fourth Keyword, Fifth Keyword, Sixth Keyword.

1. Introduction

This template gives you guidelines for preparing papers in Turkish Journal of Forecasting.

2. Detailed Formats of Manuscript

This section describes how to prepare each part of the final manuscript more specifically. Your manuscript should be typed single-spaced in single-column format on one side of a sheet only, with margins of about 1.5 cm on left and right side and 2.5 cm on top and bottom side, respectively, of each page. The suggested length of a regular paper should be 6-12 pages in this style.

First order headings should be Times New Roman 12-point boldface, initially capitalised, flush left, with one blank line before, and one blank line after.

Second-order headings (Sub-heading) should be Times New Roman 10-point boldface, initially capitalised, flush left, with one blank line before, and one after.

Third -order headings (Sub-heading) should be Times New Roman 10-point boldface, initially capitalised, flush left, with one blank line before, and one after.

Sub-headings may as well not exceed further than third-step lower level.

As for the fonts and the sizes of the headings, this manuscript in itself constitutes a good example. The paper should be written in A4 (210mm by 297mm) size. All fonts are Times New Roman.

2.1. Main Title and Author Affiliation

The font size of the title and the authors is bold 14 pt and 10 pt, respectively. Author names are to be left- justified beneath the title and printed in Times New Roman 10-point, non-boldface type. Affiliations are to be centred beneath italicised the author names and printed in Times New Roman 8-point, non-boldface type.

Corresponding author should have an asterisk sign (*), after the corresponding author's name. The Corresponding author (e.g., *Corresponding Author) label should be appeared in the footnote section of the first page of the paper, Times New Roman in style and 8 in font size. Please also add the e-mail addresses and ORCID ID of each author.

2.2. Abstract and Keywords

Before the body of the abstract and the keywords, the terms 'Abstract -' and 'Keywords:' should come in bold 10 pts, respectively. Abstract text length should not be longer than 250 words and should not be less than 50 words, including spaces. Please, provide a minimum three and maximum of six keywords in alphabetical order, separated by commas.

2.3. Body

Full-length papers generally, for example, consist of introduction, nomenclature, if any, main parts of the body, conclusions and discussions. The font sizes of the section headings are bold 12 pts and those of the subsection headings bold 10 pts, respectively.

2.4. References and Authors' Information

- All in-text citations should refer to:

1. For references with one author: the author's family name and the year of publication.

Example: "Egrioglu (2024) proposed a..."

2. For references with two authors: both authors' family names and the year of publication.

Example: "Egrioglu and Bas (2024) proposed a ..."

3. For references with three or more authors: first author's family name followed by "et al." and the year of publication.

Example: Egrioglu et al (2024) proposed a ..."

Groups of references should be listed first alphabetically, then by year.

Example: "Egrioglu et al. (2024a, 2024b, 2024c) proposed a..."

- Citations in the text: Please ensure that every reference cited in the text is also present in the reference list (and vice versa).
- Citations in the text should be written in the reference section in accordance with the citation style used by the American Psychological Association (APA).
- In the list, references should be sorted first alphabetically and then further sorted by year if necessary. More than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters "a", "b", "c", etc., placed after the year of publication.
- List all authors up to six, and if there are more than six authors, list the first six followed by "et al."
- Citing and listing of web references. As a minimum, the full URL should be given and the date when the reference was last accessed. Any further information, if known (author names, dates, reference to a source publication, etc.), should also be given.

2.5. Equations

Including symbols and equations in the text, the variable name and style must be consistent with those in the equations. Equations should be indented at the left margin and numbered at the right margin, equation number is enclosed with open and close parenthesis () Time New Roman in style and 10pt font size. Define all symbols the first time they are used. All equation symbols must be defined in a clear and understandable way.

For Example:

2.6. Tables

The text must include a citation of each table. Place tables as close as possible to the text they refer to and aligned centre. A table is labelled Table and given a number. It should be numbered consecutively. The table label and caption or title appear 12pt space above the table, 6pt space after the text or paragraph. The table should be uniformed fonts and font size, and use 8pt font size and Times New Roman style and aligned centre.

For example:

2.7. Figures

The text must include a citation of each figure. Place figures as close as possible to the text they refer to and aligned centre. A figure is labelled Figure and given a number. It should be numbered consecutively. The table label and caption or title appear 6pt space above the table, 12pt space after the text or paragraph. The figure should be uniformed fonts and font size, and use 8pt font size and Times New Roman style and aligned left.

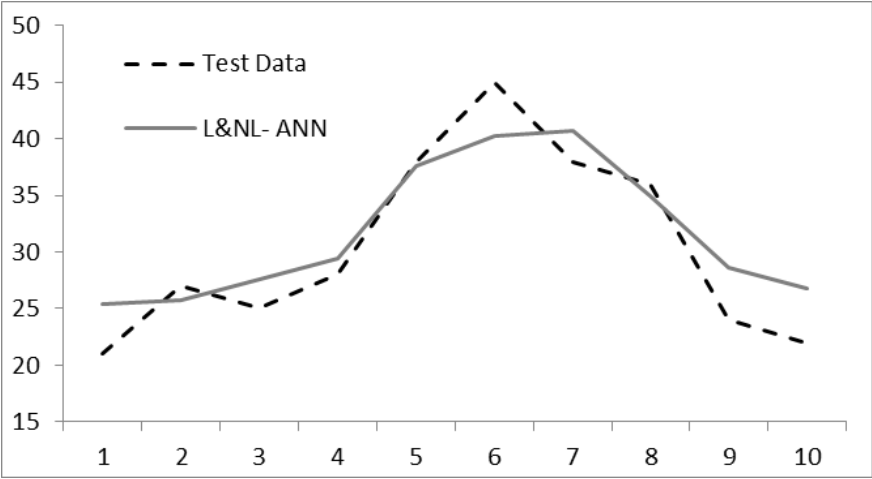


Figure 1. Figure label
