Sophomore Year Schedule

English- Required

- English 10
- Honors English 10

History

- Depending on the type of diploma you are trying to get, you may or may not have to take a history class. Remember that you must have 3 credits for a standard diploma and 4 for the advanced diploma. US History and Government must be taken in the 11th and 12th grade so you would need 1 (for standard) and 2 (for advanced) more history classes. **World Geography, World History I and World History II** would be the classes you would need for this requirement.
- Electives – Current Affairs, Street Law, Sociology, Psychology, DE Sociology, DE Psychology, DE Appalachian History, African American History and Literature

- Geometry

- Biology

World Languages – if needed or wanted

Health & PE – must have passed Health & PE 9

- Health & PE 10 / Drivers Education
- Electives- Advanced PE/ Weightlifting Boys or Girls

CTE Business Management and Administration- if needed or wanted

Fine Arts- if needed or wanted

Career & Technical Education- 10th grade students may take Culinary Arts, Auto Technology, Auto Body, Cosmetology, Carpentry, Welding class if they are 16 years old by **October 1st. No exceptions to this age requirement.** All other classes are available without age restrictions.

Many of our Career and Technical classes are 2 or 4 credit classes therefore students must have the space available to take those courses after they have signed up for required classes. Make sure you have the available space!

Things to Remember for Sophomores:

- Check Your Graduation Requirements
- Check Verified Credits (Passed SOL's)
- Check that you have 2 **sequential electives** (2 classes in the same concentration- (EX. Art I and Art II)
- Choose 8 classes and 2 alternate classes- alternates are important in case you do not get in a class that you requested.
- Complete your Graduation Requirements Worksheet and use it to complete your schedule.
