Doula Design Document

Business Purpose	This module will provide information for Labor Doulas regarding the importance of emotional support to a pregnant woman. Emotional support can dramatically reduce the stress upon a pregnant woman who is in labor.
	Maintain a clear definition of the role of the Doula. There are parameters that must be understood so that Doulas do not find themselves in legal situations.
	Recognize ways to provide emotional support for pregnant women prior to labor and in labor to reduce the stress upon the woman and the child.
Target Audience	 Newly trained Doulas or those who require a refresher for ongoing certification
Training Time	30 minutes to complete all of the required reading and tasks
