- 4. Complete and send the **Applicant's Personal Information** portion along with your essays by the **January 14, 2019 deadline.**
- 5. You will receive a confirmation email within 24 hours of reciept. If you do not receive this email then your application was not received.
- 6. Applicants will be informed in mid-March, 2019 regarding acceptance.
