



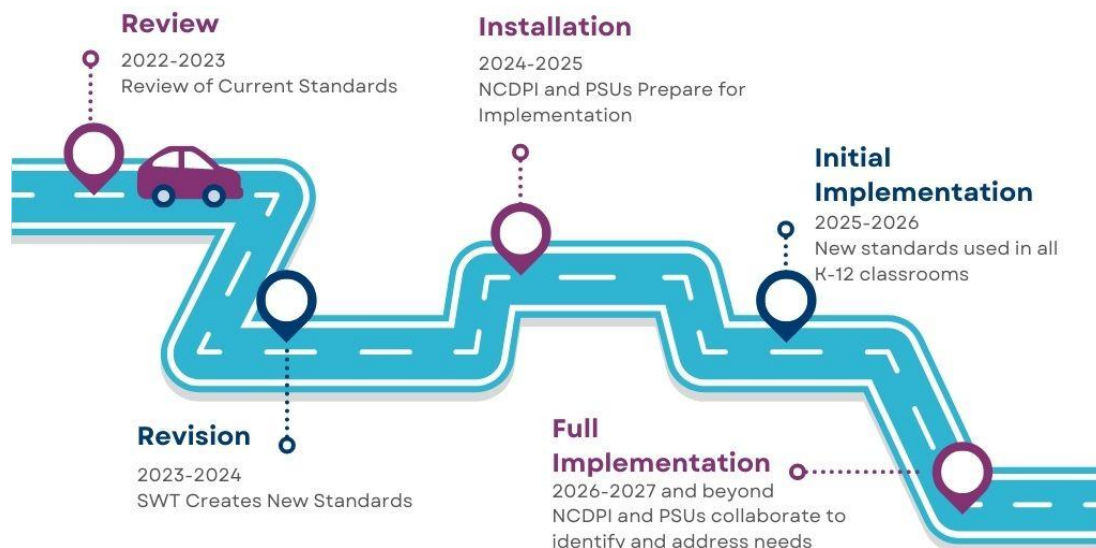

Standards Review Surveys, Applications, and Updates

The NC Standard Course of Study review and revision process is underway for Arts Education, Guidance, Healthful Living, Science, and World Languages. There are a variety of ways for individuals to give feedback, starting with the Standard-by-Standard surveys. You can also become involved in the different phases with opportunities like the Data Review Committee (DRC) and stay current on the progress being made by subscribing to updates.

[NCDPI's Office of Academic Standards](#) serves as the authoritative source for the review, revision, and support for the implementation of state content standards in the *North Carolina Standard Course of Study* (SCOS).

During the 2022 - 2023 school year, three content areas (Arts Education, Guidance, and World Languages) are in the **review phase** as outlined on pages 11 - 16 in the [North Carolina SCOS Internal Procedures Manual](#) and illustrated in this graphic.

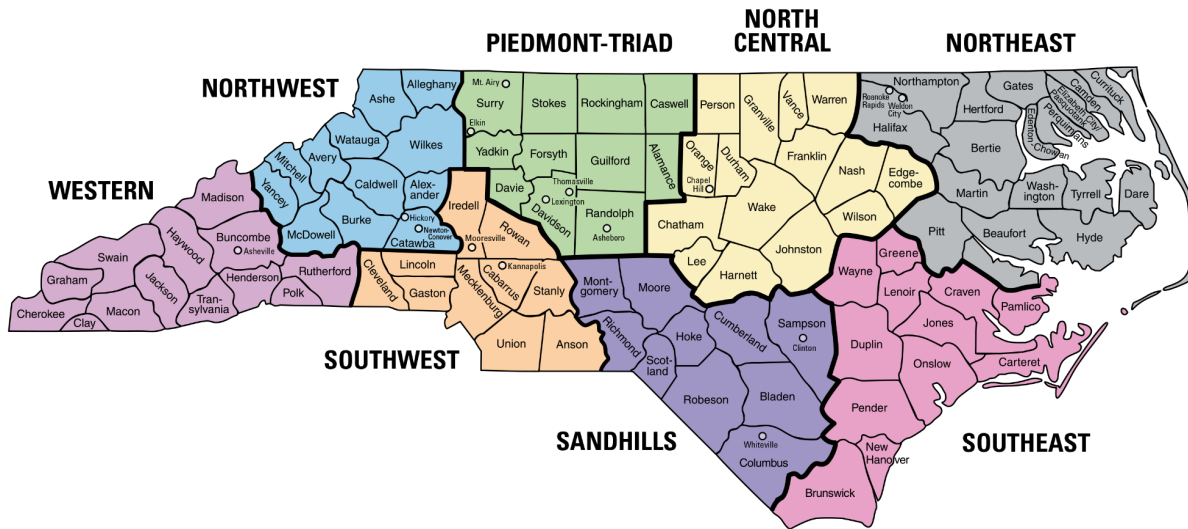
Also, **Data Review Committee (DRC) applications** for all three areas are now open through **Friday, November 18, 2022**.

DRC members review the data collected and compiled from Standard-by-Standard surveys, regional focus groups, and interviews, as well as research, policies, and legislation that pertain to education for that content area. Additional details about the DRC Scope of Work are included on the landing page of each application.

Note: The DRC analyzes the feedback and makes recommendations that help drive both the review and revision phases, so individuals chosen for the DRC cannot serve on the Standards Writing Team (SWT) that is convened during the revision phase.

Each DRC will consist of a range of external stakeholders, including: K-12 educators, educational leaders, university professors, content professionals, experts from partner organizations, and community members. The DRC members will be chosen from across the state's eight regions (pictured in the map below) and represent varying perspectives and experiences regarding the current Standard Course of Study.
