Colorado Energy Office Electrification Rebate Program and Geothermal Grant Pilot Program: Claims Forms for [Homeowners](#) and [Contractors](#). (send completed forms to Victor.Gutierrez@state.co.us).

This rebate is for community members impacted by any state declared disasters from 2018 to present for houses that were destroyed or damaged. Residents qualify for a \$10,000 - \$20,000 rebate through the Colorado Energy Office.

Rebate Options

- Option #1: Electrification using air source heat pump - Rebate \$10,000, or
- Option #2: Electrification using ground source heat pump - Rebate \$20,000, or
- Option #3: Rebate for only ground source heat pump of \$10,000
- **Applicants may claim funds for the completion of any of the three rebate options offered. A maximum of \$20,000 per household is available.**
