I II	Course Description/Outline (reflects needed skills) This class concentrates on many advanced areas of photography: technical skills, creativity, composition, computer/digital imaging, and many alternative processes including negative prints, cyanotypes, solarized prints, cross processed, and photo transfers. Completion of both semesters meets the Fine Arts requirement and/or the Applied Arts for Aptos High School, State University and UC. Control of photo equipment and techniques, experimentation, problem solving, and portfolio development are critical to the course. This course is designed for students with previous experience in traditional darkroom and digital photography. Continuation of learning Adobe platforms such as Lightroom and Photoshop will be addressed. Units of Study (activities)				
	Projects: Cyanotypes, Negative Prints, Sabattier Prints, Cross Processed Prints, Emulsion transfer/lift off, Polaroid transfers, Pushing and Pulling exposure and advanced exposure control, as well as advanced processing techniques.
