

Lesson Plan: Utilizing Multiple Intelligences with Virtual Choir

Lesson Title: "Strengthening Cross-Cultural Communication Through Collective Singing"

Objectives:

Enhance students' cross-cultural communication skills.

Strengthen students' different intelligence types through multiple intelligences.

Enable students to understand each other through collaborative music.

Age Group: Students aged 7-11

Outcomes:

Sample Activities:

Lyric Writing: Each student will write lyrics reflecting their country's culture, utilizing numerical, visual, and verbal intelligence skills.

Visual Presentation: Students will create posters and images to visually present their lyrics, emphasizing their visual intelligence skills.

Song Performance: Students will perform the song composed by Sweden in their native languages and in English, enhancing their musical intelligence.

Cross-Cultural Communication Presentation: Students will give short presentations introducing their cultures, improving their cross-cultural communication skills.

Outcomes:
