

# CTTC Team League Spring 2026

A new team league will start on **Thursday, February 19, 2026** at CTTC (Columbus Table Tennis Club). The new league will have the same format as the [previous \(31\) CTTC leagues](#). Matches are played on Thursday evenings.

The following supplies league details and requests that signups begin immediately.

## LEAGUE RULES SUMMARY:

1. The league will use standard USATT rules but will not be associated with the USATT. This includes legal serves and no white clothing.
2. The league is open to CTTC members as well as non-members.
3. Each team consists of 3 players designated A, B, & C.
4. Each team will play one team match (*tie*) each week.
5. A *tie* consists of the following 9 matches:
  - a. 9 Singles Matches:
    - i. A1 vs A2, B2, C2
    - ii. B1 vs A2, B2, C2
    - iii. C1 vs A2, B2, C2
  - b. 2 Doubles Matches will alternate from these 3 matchups:
    - i. A1/B1 vs A2/B2
    - ii. B1/C1 vs B2/C2
    - iii. A1/C1 vs A2/C2
6. Singles and doubles matches will be the best of 5 games, each game consists of 11 points.
7. Any combination of at least 6 match wins will determine the tie winner.
8. Players are ranked according to one of the following:
  - a. An average of their previous league rating, USATT rating (if less than 1 year old), and the Singles Round Robin tournaments.
  - b. An average of 2 of the above if all 3 do not exist.
  - c. One of the above if it exists.
  - d. A committee of club/league experts will rank players with no league, USATT, or Singles Round Robin tournament rating.
9. Teams are formed by designating the highest ranked players as A players and each will select their B & C players from the pool of players according to a draft order designed for competitive league play.
10. Substitutes for players unable to play can be any player that has an equal or lower ranking than the missing player.
11. The games start at 7:30 pm on Thursday evenings at the club location at 653 East 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
12. Play begins on Thursday, July 10, 2025. League Managers conduct a team draft a day or two before the league begins. The league will run for a complete round in which each team will play every other team (6 to 10 weeks).

13. There is a league fee of **\$35** per person. **Please note that this does not include normal club playing fees.** The league fees pay for balls, CTTC Donation of 25% and awards.
14. The awards include:
  - a. 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place teams
  - b. Highest percentage singles game wins for A, B and C players
  - c. Highest percentage match wins for AB doubles and BC doubles
  - d. Most Improved Player through the league
15. Award winning players will get to choose their award: trophy, cash, or balls.

17. If you cannot commit to playing every week, consider signing up as a substitute player but there is no guarantee that you will get to play.
18. Please spread this message to everyone you think might be interested.
19. Sign-up cutoff date is February 14, 2026. League fees are due on that date. If not paid by this date, your name will be removed from the signup sheet.
