

Yearbook Senior Photo Specifications

Photos are Due by OCTOBER 31!!!

Please adhere to the following photo specs for senior portraits:

- Upload all photos to:

<https://photos.jostens.com/RD8DWH>

- Your picture file should be in the following format: last name, first name student ID#
 - example Smith, Joseph 26999
- To include your senior quote and activities you should upload your photo yourself. If your photographer sends it in someone from the yearbook committee will be in touch with you to get that information
- Portraits may be color or black and white but must be school appropriate
 - The yearbook is reviewed by administration prior to publication and reserves the right to ask for a different picture
- Portraits must be vertical.
 - *If you submit a horizontal photo, it will not fit our vertical template.*
- Digital images must be a minimum 1 MB file size or at the very least a resolution of 300dpi for optimal clarity. .JPG files only.
- Picture size - 640px x 800px minimum
- All files must be RGB file format only (no CMYK).
- Photos will look blurry on your side when uploading, that is the compression of the file. Don't be concerned, it looks perfect on our end! (If it doesn't someone will be in touch!)

Portraits deemed unacceptable by the yearbook staff will not be used and you will be contacted for a replacement.
