Standardized Attendance Accounting Update June 5, 2025

We spoke with the CCCCO this morning and was advised of the following:

- 1. The new Standardized Attendance Accounting repeals all the scheduling limitations associated with census courses. A college can use the Standardized Attendance Accounting method with ANY credit course regardless of how it is scheduled.

 Example in question: Police Academy with one week where additional course hours are completed on a Saturday. This class CAN be classified as a Census Course and use the new Standardized Attendance Accounting method.
- 2. Colleges CAN continue to utilize the Positive Attendance method for a section of ANY credit course should they choose to do so. While the CCCCO is encouraging the review of all credit courses to ensure the units are properly aligned, there is no requirement to update the units for courses where the Positive Attendance method will be employed. Daily hour-for-hour attendance records are required for all these courses.
