

Galing Kabataan General Guidelines

1. **The Galing Kabataan Initiative** is an awards mechanism for recognizing programs, projects or activities for children and youth, getting them funded and implemented and measuring their outputs and impacts to the children and youth in particular and the community in general
2. **The main objective** of the Galing Kabataan is to facilitate the selection and implementation of the banner program of each LGU Team.
3. Each LGU may develop its own process but the **general mechanics** are as follows:
 - 3.1. LGU Teams will develop the mechanics and criteria for the Galing Kabataan Awards. These will be disseminated by the provincial government to all the municipal/city LGUs and Sangguniang Kabataan Federations, or by the pilot city/municipal government to all the SK Councils.
 - 3.2. The LGU Teams will also appoint the screening committee and judges for the Galing Pook Awards.
 - 3.3. SK Federations/Councils are eligible to submit an entry and must prepare the necessary documents or means of verifications. The Screening Committee will then review the entries and make a shortlist of programs that may be worthy of recognition.
 - 3.4. The panel of judges will then review the shortlisted programs. From the short list, the panel of judges will select a winner (or a set of winners).
 - 3.5. The winning program/s may be enhanced further by the LGU and showcased as a banner program at the end of the course.
4. The LGU will provide funding for the Galing Kabataan Awards.
5. Galing Pook Mentors and Youth Facilitators will provide mentoring and technical expertise.
