 - b. **Green (Connections)** - Sentences that connect to your life from other science lessons, other classes, or experiences from your life. You will need to create a comment from that sentence containing the question you have.
 - c. **Orange (Expand)** - Sentences that you would like to expand on as you look further into this topic. You will need to create a comment explaining what additional information you would want to search for.
