2) Дайте ученикам предложения (я выделила их синим цветом здесь) и попросите вставить в их таблицу в соответствующие графы.

Это задание поможет разобраться в значениях видо-временных форм и будет служить опорным конспектом для работы с грамматическими упражнениями по теме.
