AWR Information	At the end of the semester, Mr. D. Math will go in and close classes. Students are shifted to a "complete" area in their accounts where HSTs should be able to see grades and assignments. Instructions on how to print the gradebook can be found in the Popular Curriculum spreadsheet.
Withdrawing from a Course	Mr. D offers a 30-day money-back guarantee. The 30 days start from the first day the student uses the course. IEP or 504 Plan?	Mr. D Math provides one to three live Zoom help sessions each week where students can receive extra help. All Mr. D math courses have the following accommodations: • Extra time on all quizzes/tests • 2 attempts on quizzes • Students are permitted to use their notes and coursework on all quizzes, tests, and exams • Quizzes and tests can be submitted after the due date without penalty to their grade. (The HST and the parent are responsible for managing the student's schedule and due dates, not the Mr. D Math staff) • If students need extra help with breaking down their assignments for math classes, they can attend our extra help sessions (AKA office hours) 3 days per week to ask additional questions • All live classes are recorded, and all lessons have prerecorded videos that stream online. These videos can be sped up, slowed down or played at regular speed to accommodate a student's specific need. <i>There are no extra special permissions needed to use the accommodations above, as they are already integrated into the program.</i>



Good To Know

Students will receive online access to printable worksheets; there are no workbooks or textbooks to purchase. Prior to each class, the student & parent receive an email letting them know what worksheets to print out for the upcoming class session. The instructor guides students through the first problem on each worksheet or section. Students then complete problems from their worksheet(s) on their own prior to attending the next class session.

Answer keys are available online so that the student's parent or learning coach is able to grade the student's worksheet prior to the next class. Answer keys provide the steps to solving each problem and are color-coded, allowing for very ease of use and also for determining where a student went wrong in the case of an incorrect answer.

The online platform Mr. D Math uses establishes start and end dates that cannot be manually adjusted. For example, the Fall 2025 semester end date is listed in Mr. D Math's system as 12/18/25. However, students can continue working in their courses through the last day of our school's semester (1/9/2025 for the Fall 2025 semester).
