Activities:	<p>Daytime (8am-4pm)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Delivery of notices about the event to local houses (week before) • Preventing people parking cars in the area • Generally helping with setting-up of equipment and facilities • Giving out programmes to the public at Brockley Station <p>Evening (4-11pm)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Selling raffle tickets to tickets-buyers • Handing out programmes to the audience • Actively ensuring the health and safety of all attendees • Preventing unauthorized access to the restricted areas by attendees • Providing help and support to the emergency services in the event of a major incident • Reporting any anti-social behavior, illegal activity or any potential danger to the security of the workers or volunteer co-ordinator • Picking up litter • Generally helping with breakdown of equipment and facilities

- Familiarize themselves with festival risk assessments and take responsibility for their own personal health, safety and wellbeing
- Work at all times in accordance with volunteer policies and procedures
