## Seed Labeling

Saved seed should be labeled with as much information as possible. At a minimum the label should include:

- common name,
- variety (or description)
- grower and
- date harvested.
- Bonus points for sharing the following: botanical name, number of plants collected from, where isolation methods used, location, and a picture of the crop/plant/ and seeds.

Here is a label that can be printed and filled out:

 6-to- 1 page seed packet label template .pdf

 9-to- 1 page seed packet label template .pdf

Share commercial seed in its original packaging.
