

## REFLECTIONS ON RESPONSIBILITY

### Purpose

The Holocaust is one of the most devastating examples of injustice in world history. This activity helps you reflect on who holds responsibility for atrocities like the Holocaust. You'll take a stance, support it with evidence from the lesson, and consider what this means for your role in standing up to injustice.

### Process

1. Consider this statement: *Ordinary people bear just as much responsibility for atrocities as leaders.*
2. Determine the extent to which you agree or disagree with the statement. Place an "X" on the continuum to represent your position.
