- For postgraduate studies, the average annual cost is around £17,109, but it can also vary within the same range of £11,400 to £38,000.
- International students from non-EU countries typically cannot access student loans from the UK government. However, some universities offer loan schemes to support talented students from low-income backgrounds, including non-EU applicants.

- Under the Graduate Route visa, there are pathways to apply for long-term work visas.

To work legally, you must be enrolled in a full-time course and hold a student visa. During term time, work is limited to a maximum of 20 hours per week, including unpaid roles, but this increases to up to 40 hours per week during out-of-term periods. Students can work part-time (20 hours/week) and earn £9-£12 per hour, totalling around £720-£880 per month.
