



Clark County School District English Learner School Support Team 2025–2026 Deployment Strategy

Description

The English Learner (EL) school support team aims to partner with school leadership teams to accelerate language development and improve the academic outcomes for ELs districtwide during the 2025–2026 school year. The EL school support team will focus on the instructional supports delineated below.

- Co-planning and co-teaching instruction
- Modeling lessons
- Facilitating professional learning communities
- Conducting coaching cycles
- Delivering professional learning
- Participating in instructional rounds utilizing the Tier I monitoring tool

The EL school support team will spend 80 percent of its time directly at schools providing support. The [Multilingual Learner Instructional Pathways Implementation Guide](#) will serve as a resource to provide high-quality, standards-based content and language development instruction to support the academic achievement of all students.

Deployment Strategy

The English Language Learner Division (ELLD) has developed a deployment strategy to ensure essential support for all schools, with targeted support for identified focus schools.

EL General Instructional Support for All Schools

- Foundational support to enhance outcomes for ELs is outlined in the [Cadence of EL General School Instructional Support](#) document.
- Actively partnering with school leadership teams to:
 - Leverage School Improvement Plans to support ELs.
 - Provide a clear overview of available instructional pathways.
 - Ensure schools have access to all necessary EL resources, and provide direct instructional support for teachers guiding students through Tier II EL pathways.

EL Specialized Instructional Support for Focus Schools

- In addition to the EL general school instructional support, focus schools will receive more specialized support as outlined in the [Cadence of EL Focus School Instructional Support](#) document
- School Associate Superintendents identified an estimated 20 schools per Region, driven by specific school needs, such as EL enrollment numbers, EL student typologies, and EL achievement data
