Meeting Notes

- Call Meeting to Order and Review of Requirements for Voting The meeting was called to order @ 7:30pm
- Approval of meeting notes from August meeting The August Meeting Notes were approved without objection
- Federal/ State/ City/ School/ Other Elected Officials 5 minutes per presenter
 - Atlanta Police Department Officer Robert Godwin shared that crime statistics in Zone 6 continue to trend down. Vehicle break ins and vehicle theft (due to cars being left running) are the most frequent crime. Most violent crime is domestic violence or gang related.
- Announcements 5 minutes per item
 - o Beautification Financial Agreement with Urban Farm Ormewood, Inc (UFO) being finalized. The UFO/SAND fiscal agent agreement is under final review and should be completed this month.
 - o Treasurer 2024 Makers Festival funds distribution recommendation for consideration and vote. A motion to approve distribution of \$6,000 was approved without objection. Tapestry Greenspace, Urban Farm in Ormewood, Inc., and Friends of Benteen Park will each be receiving \$1,500. \$1,500 will also be allocated to the "Festival Reserve".
 - o Transportation
 - SMAWG Update Brent Huff (SMAWG Co-Chair) gave an update on the timing of installation of several crosswalks with Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons which is expected to be complete in the next 12-18 months. Additionally, sidewalk improvement plans should be completed by the end of the year. The reconfiguration of the I-20/Moreland Avenue interchange is expected to begin construction Spring of 2025.
 - Beltline Rail Now update will be on the October Agenda
 - o Benteen Park Fall Fest Update
 - Sign Toppers CMG sign topper purchase and installation pending neighborhood agreement on design update. Neighborhood voting on sign designs is ongoing.
 - o Elections are coming! for SAND and NPU-W. Let folks know if you are interested in a leadership role. No position is a lifetime commitment! Please reach out to President@sandatlanta.org if you are interested in being a candidate.
- City of Atlanta Matters for Voting:
 - Z-24-59 City ordinance to remove 103 billboards and allow relocation/ conversion of 27 billboards, for purposes of moving billboards away from neighborhood areas and placing them more centrally around major vehicular corridors.
