

For new families, please bring a proof of residency from each of the categories listed below.

**Category I - One Proof Required:** At least one of the following documents showing the name and residence address of the parent/guardian or caregiver within the district: (Education Code 48204.1)

- a. A copy of the deed
- b. A copy of the most recent mortgage statement
- c. Property tax bill/payment receipt dated within the past year
- d. A copy of the fully executed lease/rental agreement. The lease/rental agreement must show the rental address and include the lessor/lessee names and signatures
- e. Pay Stub
- f. Voter Registration
- g. Correspondence from a government agency
- h. Declaration of Residency executed by the student's parent/legal guardian

For returning students, please bring a proof of residency from one of the categories below.

**Category II - One Proof Required:** At least one utility service statement or payment receipt dated within the last forty-five (45) days showing the name and service address of the parent/guardian or caregiver within the district. On-line documentation is accepted as long as it fulfills the requirement of a complete statement (all pages). Utility set-up and 15 day notice letters are

acceptable proofs of residency if statement or payment receipt is submitted within 30 days of residency verification.

Acceptable utility services include: (Education Code 48204.1)

- a. PG&E
- b. Nevada Irrigation District (NID)
- c. Waste Management
- d. Residential cable/internet/satellite
- e. Landline telephone (cell and long-distance service not accepted).

If the student is an unaccompanied youth as defined in 42 USC 11434A, a declaration of residency executed by the student will be required.

If the student is residing in the home of a caregiving adult within district boundaries, an affidavit executed by the caregiving adult in accordance with Family Code 6552 will be required.
